- What is happening?
- What happens next?
- What is inside the egg?
- Where might this be happening?



## Respond

Write a diary entry for each of the first few days of a newborn chick. How did it feel when the chick hatched from the egg? What could it see? Was it scary for the first few days? What did it come across?



## Reimagine

Think of a way you could represent new life. If you could use any medium you wanted, what would you choose?



## Discuss

Life is a precious thing and should be treasured. Do you agree with this statement? Does it matter what the life belongs to? Is human life more precious than that of a chick or a hedgehog? Why? Should we not celebrate and cherish the life of every living thing?



## Solve

Max's chicken, Henrietta, lays one egg every day for the month of January. She lays one egg every other day for the month of February. How many eggs does she lay over these two months?



**Challenge:** Max's other chickens, Mildred and Gertrude lay five fewer eggs each than Henrietta in the given time. How many eggs have all three laid over the two months?

## Discover

**Fact:** Spring is the season associated with new life and rebirth. It is a time when days get longer and the environment around us changes in many different ways.

**Question:** What exactly are the changes? What is the new life associated with spring? What is rebirth?



# Life Answers

How many eggs does she lay over these two months?	How many eggs have all three laid over the two months?
$31 + 14 = 45$ eggs	Mildred and Gertrude would have laid 40 eggs each. $40 + 40 + 45 = 125$ eggs in total.
