Week Beginning 4.5.20

Last week, we had the option of using the White Rose EYFS plans plus the activities that you'll see again, below. It is important that the children get a good mix of experiences (Those that are manageable at home. Please do not get into a position where these cause too much worrying for you or your child!) With this in mind, I am putting a copy of last week's Maths planner below - for ease of access. Notice that I have also written a new planner that can accompany the White Rose resources underneath this table. **This week's Maths can be taken from either table, all depending on what you accessed last week.**
